2. Please write in block letters the full name(s) and address(es) as registered in the register of members.
3. If any person other than the chairman of the AGM is preferred, strike out "the chairman of the AGM (as defined below) or" and insert the full name(s) of proxy(ies) in the space provided in block letters. Shareholders may appoint one or more proxies to attend the AGM and to vote thereat. The proxy(ies) need(s) not be shareholder(s) of the Company. Any alteration made herein must be initiated by the signatory(ies).
4. Please note that if you would like to vote for any resolution, you should put "✓" in the "For" column. If you would like to vote against any resolution, you should put "✗" in the "Against" column. If you would like to abstain from any resolution, you should put "✓" in the "Abstain" column (abstain votes will not be counted as voting "for"). If no instruction is given, the proxy(ies) is/are authorized to vote at his/her/their discretion.
5. The Company will adopt the cumulative voting system for voting on sub-resolutions 8.01-8.06 of the resolution No. 8 and sub-resolutions 9.01-9.04 of the resolution No. 9 in accordance with its Articles of Association.
 - (i) Take resolution No.8 as an example, in respect of sub-resolutions No.8.01 to No.8.06, each share held will entitle you to the same number of voting rights as the number of directors to be elected under the resolution. For instance, if you hold 1 million shares and there are 6 directors to be elected under resolution No. 8 (i.e., sub-resolutions No. 8.01 to No. 8.06), the aggregate number of votes which you will have for sub-resolutions No. 8.01 to No. 8.06 will be 6 million (i.e., 1 million shares x 6 = 6 million voting rights);
 - (ii) No ballot will be cast as "For", "Against" or "Abstain" in cumulative voting. You are requested to fill in the corresponding number of votes in the "Cumulative Voting" column next to the name of each candidate. The lowest votes will be zero, and the highest will be the maximum number of votes under each resolution. These votes do not need to be in integral multiples of the number of shares held by you. If you mark "✓" in the blank next to the name of each candidate, you will be deemed to cast your total number of votes equally amongst the corresponding candidates. Please note that if you mark a "✓" and also fill in a specific number of votes in the "Cumulative Voting" column for a candidate, the number you have filled in will prevail for vote counting purposes. For the avoidance of doubt, you are not required to mark a "✓" in the "Cumulative Voting" column. Instead, you should fill in the "Cumulative Voting" column with the number of votes you wish to cast for each candidate.
 - (iii) Please note that you may either cast all your votes to one of the proposed candidates, or cast them equally or differently among more than one candidate. For example, if you hold 1 million shares, the aggregate number of votes you have for sub-resolution No. 8.01 to No. 8.06 is 6 million. You may choose to cast all 6 million votes equally among the 6 candidates, or allocate all your votes (6 million) to a single candidate. Alternatively, you may choose to cast, for example, 0.5 million votes to Candidate A, 0.5 million votes to Candidate B, and allocate the remaining votes among the other candidates, or any other distribution of your votes among the six candidates;
 - (iv) The total number of your votes cast for the candidates shall not exceed the aggregate number of votes to which you are entitled;
 - (v) Please note that if the total votes cast by you on the candidates exceeds the total votes to which you are entitled, all the votes cast will become invalid and treated as abstain votes; if the total votes you cast are less than or equal to the total votes to which you are entitled, those votes will be valid and the remaining votes will be treated as abstain votes. For example, if you hold 1 million shares, the total number of votes you may cast for sub-resolutions No. 8.01 to No. 8.06 of resolution No.8 is 6 million:
 - (a) If you allocate all 6 million votes to one candidate, you will have used up all your votes. Any attempt to allocate votes to other candidates will result in all your votes for sub-resolutions No. 8.01 to No. 8.06 being invalid;
 - (b) If you allocate 0.5 million votes to each of the six candidates, the 3 million votes cast will be valid, and the remaining 3 million votes will be considered as abstained votes.
 - (vi) where the votes cast for a particular candidate for director of the Company are more than half of the total number of shares held by all shareholders attending the AGM (prior to the application of cumulative voting), such candidate shall be elected as the director of the Company.
6. This proxy form or other power of attorney must be duly signed by you or your attorney duly authorized in writing. If the appointor is a legal person, the proxy form shall be affixed with the seal of the legal person or signed by its director(s) or duly authorized representative(s). If the appointor is a joint holder, this proxy form shall be signed by the shareholder whose name stands first among such joint shareholders in the register of members.
7. If this proxy form is signed by a person who is authorized by the appointor, the power of attorney or other authority under which it is signed must be notarized by a notary public. In order to be valid, such notarized power of attorney or other authority together with this proxy form must be deposited at the office address of the Company's H Share registrar, namely Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong (for holders of H shares) no less than 24 hours before the time appointed for the holding of the AGM.
8. This proxy form shall not preclude the appointor to attend the AGM in person and to vote thereat. In such event, the appointment of the original proxy(ies) will be void.
