The maximum number of 83,000,000 Placing Shares represent (i) 20.00% of the existing issued share capital of the Company as at the date of this announcement; and (ii) approximately 16.67% of the existing issued share capital of the Company as enlarged by the Placing (assuming the maximum number of Placing Shares are placed). The aggregate nominal value of the maximum number of Placing Shares under the Placing is HK\$830,000.

Assuming the maximum number of the Placing Shares has been placed, the gross proceeds from the Placing will be HK\$60.59 million and the net proceeds will be approximately HK\$59 million (after deduction of commission and other expenses of the Placing). It is expected that the entire net proceeds from the Placing will be utilised for general working capital and/or future investment of the Group as and when opportunities arise, but no specific investment targets have been identified yet as at the date of this announcement.

Placees:

The maximum number of 83,000,000 Placing Shares represent (i) 20.00% of the existing issued share capital of the Company as at the date of this announcement; and (ii) approximately 16.67% of the existing issued share capital of the Company as enlarged by the Placing (assuming the maximum number of Placing Shares are placed). The aggregate nominal value of the maximum number of the Placing Shares under the Placing will be HK\$830,000.

The Placing Shares will rank, upon issue and fully paid, pari passu in all respects with the Shares in issue as at the date of allotment and issue of the Placing Shares.

As disclosed above, the maximum net proceeds from the Placing are estimated to be approximately HK\$59 million.

Upon completion of the Placing, it is expected that the entire net proceeds from the Placing will be utilised for general working capital and/or future investment of the Group as and when opportunities arise, but no specific investment targets have been identified yet as at the date of this announcement. The Directors consider that given the good sentiment of the stock market in Hong Kong, the Placing is an appropriate means of raising additional working capital for the Company while broadening the Shareholder and capital base of the Company.

The Company has not conducted any equity fund raising activities for the 12 months immediately before the date of this announcement.
